

How to: Kroger Community Rewards

Step 1: Visit the [Kroger Community Rewards](#) page.

Step 2: Scroll down and click on **“Enroll.”**

Step 3: **“Sign In”** to your Kroger Plus Shopper’s Card account. *If you haven’t setup an account for your Kroger Plus Shopper’s Card, please see the other set of instructions.*

Step 4: Key in your Kroger Plus Shopper’s Card Number. (If it says that this card has already been used, please call the number on the back of your card.)

Step 5: Enter **“National MS Society”** in the box under Find Your Organization.

Step 6: Click on **“Search.”**

Step 7: Select **“National MS Society – Ohio Buckeye Chapter.”**

Step 8: Click **“Save Changes.”**

Step 9: You will then be redirected to your account page. You can verify your selection by scrolling down to the bottom of the page and under **“Community Rewards Information”** the National MS Society – Ohio Buckeye Chapter should be listed.
